



Privacy Notice

Daily Employment Services Limited takes the responsibility for and security of your data very seriously. This Privacy Policy aims to give you all the information on how we collect and process your personal data when you use our website and utilise our services. We will update this privacy policy on occasion and it is recommended that you look back at this Notice from time to time.

Daily Employment Services Limited is the registered controller and is responsible for your personal data (ICO registered number: ZA447041)

The data we collect, how we collect it and what we will do with your data and why

We will collect the following information, name, address, contact details (phone numbers and email address), Date of Birth, Tax information and National Insurance number, identification, proof of address, IP address, browser type, time zone, operating system, marketing preferences, feedback that you give us, agency details and contact, HR records and your rates of pay. We do not collect any special category data.

If you fail to provide data that is requested we may not be able to perform the contract we have, or are trying to enter, with yourself. We may have to cancel the service you have with us in this case, but we will notify you of this.

We will collect this information direct from yourself by filling in of application forms or by correspondence by post, phone and email etc., when you apply for our services, give us feedback or enquire about our services. We may also receive this personal data from a third party introducer or brokerage upon your request to them. We will process your data to fulfil contractual and legal obligations and with your consent on occasion. We may occasionally use your data for our legitimate business reasons for marketing and communications to ensure the information we hold is up to date and to ensure our services are the best that we can offer you, we shall only use your information for these reasons where our legitimate interests does not outweigh your rights and freedoms. You have the right to withdraw consent to marketing at any time and the right to object to us using your data for legitimate business reasons.

Daily Employment Services Limited will share your data with third parties for contractual and legal purposes, we will not give your information to third parties for their own marketing without your express permission, we may provide you with marketing from third parties from time to time for legitimate business reasons you may opt out of this at any time. Daily Employment Services Limited outsource certain aspects of their business to third parties, every effort has been made to ensure that your data is secure with these outsources and this is continually monitored and we remain the controller of your data. Data is not shared outside of the EEA, however if this were necessary we will ensure adequate data protection policies in order to ensure data is kept securely and inform you of this transfer.



How long we keep your data

Who we share your data with
